
## Fees and Donations in Schools - Compulsory/Not Compulsory Flowchart



The Ministry pays for Itinerant Teachers of Music (ITMs) and this tuition is part of the school curriculum. It is reasonable for parents to be charged for the hire of musical instruments owned by the school and used by students outside the delivery of the music curriculum. Parents are sometimes asked to pay for students to attend in-school activities such as performances by visiting drama groups or lunch-time sports or EOTC activities. It should be made clear that attendance at such activities is voluntary, and that attendance incurs a charge.



The board may charge for personal printing or web usage costs (for example, personal use such as "surfing" of the web) that isn't related to curriculum delivery. To avoid misunderstanding which may lead to problems with payment, Boards of Trustees should ensure that parents are made aware of the full cost for materials for subjects where there is a take home element.
