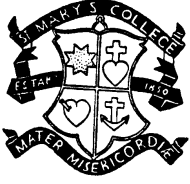

AIRPORT TRANSFERS: Long term students – first pick-up at no charge Short-term students – via Agent Subsequent transfers arranged between Agent/SMC/Student SMC recommends student's pay \$30.00 to their host family if they transfer the student. SMC can arrange airport & homestay transfers at a cost of \$65.00 each way.		

ACCOMODATION POLICY
Two weeks' notice or \$580.00 is given to the homestay if leaving regardless if the student moves out prior to the two week notice period.
A homestay placement/administration fee is charged every year at \$350.00. A homestay placement fee of \$350.00 will apply to each new or change of homestay.
Homestay families are paid \$290.00 per week during term break holidays. Students absent during term time for longer than two weeks (with Principal's approval) pay \$580.00 for two weeks and then \$50 after that (to a maximum of \$250.00).
If a student leaves the homestay at the end of the year to go home but wants to come back ("retain") to the same homestay they need to give two weeks' notice then pay \$50.00 per week Homestay Retainer Fee (to a maximum of \$250.00).
