### What to expect from the Compulsory Music Scheme (Years 7, 8 and 9):

- Half hour group lesson with an ITM (Itinerant Teacher of Music)
- 1 hour group session with the whole year group (band/orchestra) on Thursday
- Focusing on learning an instrument
- Gaining experience playing in the Year 7, 8 and 9 band/orchestra
- Learning to sing in a choir (Year 7 and 8 choir, Year 9 choir optional)
- Performing to family and friends at the end of year, at the Year 7
   & Year 8 Proms and the Year 9 & Year 10 Concert
- Cost: Instrument hire fee (if an instrument is hired from the Lyn Insley Trust), music tuition fee

## What to expect from the Voluntary Music Scheme (Years 10, 11, 12 and 13):

- Taking Music as an academic subject option
- Half hour group lesson with an ITM, if continuing in an ensemble
- Joining an ensemble (Symphonic Band, Concert Band, Jazz Band, Big Band, Chamber Orchestra, Junior Chamber Orchestra, Stella Strings, SMC Orchestra)
- Joining a choir (Stella Choir, Chamber choir)
- Participating at various competitions and tours
- Cost: Instrument hire fee (if an instrument is hired from the Lyn Insley Trust), music tuition fee, competition entry fee, transportation and/or accommodation fee to and from events/ competitions
