St. Mary's has an amazing musical tradition and it continues to this day. All St. Mary's students in Years 7-9 learn a Band or Orchestra instrument for three years and play in an ensemble. They have one timetabled lesson a week on Thursday morning (Periods 1-3). In addition, they have one half-hour group lesson a week with an Itinerant Teacher of Music (ITM) during which they come out of a scheduled class. This lesson schedule can be seen outside the SM Hall and is managed by Andrea Banbrook.
